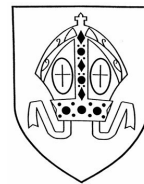

Message from the Headteacher

Dear All,

A short week for the children this week as tomorrow is a training day when we are reviewing our curriculum and how our Christian vision is embedded in threads across the years.

We usually achieve an Ashing service at The Cathedral with the option of being ashed. This year it has not been possible, but it was special that the Dean led collective worship this week. He talked not only about Shrove Tuesday but about Ash Wednesday and carbon and water; reminding us that all living things have those components in common.

Easter is very early this year and half term is not sitting in the middle of the shortest term of the year. I cannot remember a time when Valentine's Day has fallen in school time. We spend a great deal of time talking about loving our neighbour, but not encouraging romance in the primary age range. St Valentine was not only the patron saint of love and marriage, but also of bee keeping, epilepsy, fainting and the plague!

The training for our public speaking module, The Mighty Oak, aimed to develop confidence and teach the skills to speak in public took place this week. This is part of our personal development programme and happens in Year 4. It was lovely to see the children learning both subtle and dramatic techniques.

The Governors have been particularly busy this week both in school in the recruitment process for the Admissions committee process when applicants are ranked according to the Admission policy and undertaking training in the evening.

Year 4 has had the initial Kingswood trip meeting. We run this educational visit at the beginning of Year 5 as a rite of passage into Upper School. The expectation is that every child must have this opportunity as we see the impact it has on maturity, how it grows the ability to deal with challenge and it develops independence and social skills. We try to overcome all barriers to ensure equality for every child to go. As a principle in this school, it is the determination of the school that no child should be disadvantaged. 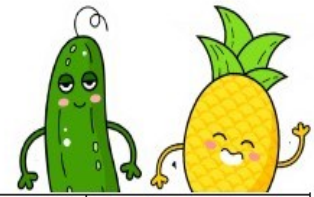

Hope has completed stage 4 of swimming and now has a blue hat, stage 5!

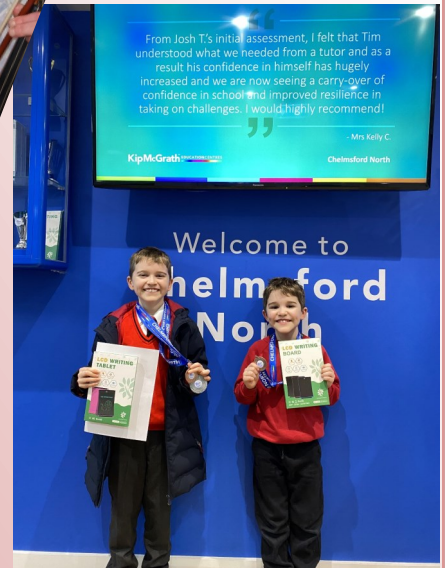
Well Done!
